2009 Razorback Road Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon



The Razorback Road is our mid price point wine aimed at the discerning drinker looking for value. Grapes are sourced from our Estate vineyard in the Adelaide Hills. The winemaking style follows the same philosophy of our super-premium wines with a two-week fermentation time to provide maximum colour, flavour and gently extracted fine tannins. Named after the location of the Estate vineyards in the Adelaide Hills, this classic Australian blend combines the spicy cool climate character of Shiraz (80%) with the black fruit and herb notes of Cabernet Sauvignon (20%). Ageing in French and American oak barriques for 12 months has imparted subtle vanillin character to complement the wines vibrant fruit flavours.

Tasting Notes

Deep red in colour with vibrant crimson hues. Elegant aromas offering raspberry and blackberry notes with more than a hint of coffee and mint, the palate shows refined forest fruit flavours supported by subtle oak and five-spice nuance. Finishes with a lingering persistence framed by fine-boned acidity and velvety tannins.
