## 2004 Adelaide Hills Chardonnay

The 2004 Anvers Adelaide Hills Chardonnay follows the success of the inaugural 2003 release. From vintage 2004 we were provided with flavoursome, elegant Chardonnay grapes from vineyards in Lenswood and Charleston. The selection of eight different French oak types, use of wild yeast and 10 months spent on yeast lees has provided a wine with soft, creamy texture and layers of subtle complexity.

### Tasting Notes

Pale yellow in colour, with a vibrant aroma of white peach and fig fruits backed by hints of nougat and cashew nuts. A powerful yet elegant style with a creamy mouth feel, the 2004 Anvers Chardonnay delivers delicious stone fruit flavours supported by profound layers of oak, yeast lees and complex shortbread nuances. Best from 2006 to 2010.
