2011 Adelaide Hills Chardonnay

The 2011 Anvers Premium Adelaide Hills Chardonnay is the first Chardonnay to be produced from grapes grown on the Anvers Kangarilla Estate Vineyard in the Adelaide Hills. The greatest care has been taken with this wine, from the handpicking of the grapes to the selection of the finest French oak to the use of wild yeast and 10 months spent on yeast lees. This care and attention has provided a wine that is finely textured with layers of subtle complexity. This wine continues a fine tradition of world class cool climate white wines from the Adelaide Hills.

Tasting Notes

Golden straw in colour, a vibrant wine with bright fruit characters, aroma of white peach, pear and fig fruits backed by hints of nougat and cashew nuts. An elegant style with a finely textured palate, the 2011 Anvers Chardonnay delivers delicious fruit flavours supported by profound layers of oak, yeast lees and complex shortbread nuances.
