



## 2005 Brabo Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz

Anvers' Estate vineyard located in the cool climate of the Adelaide Hills has been the source of our award winning Anvers Reserve Shiraz and Anvers Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon. This same vineyard has provided the grapes used to produce the second Anvers Brabo from vintage 2005.

The winemaking style for the Brabo range is focused on producing a softer, more approachable wine that can be enjoyed in its youth. By maturing the Brabo in 3-5 year old oak for 10 months, a restrained oak influence is imparted along with a freshness of fruit, providing an everyday drinking alternative to the Anvers Razorback Road Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon.

### Tasting Notes

Vibrant red in colour with crimson hues. Intenseley flavoured yet elegant, this wine combines the spice and blackberry characters of Shiraz (22%) with the refined blackcurrant flavours of Cabernet Sauvignon (78%). An aroma of soft clove and white pepper spices in the company of elegant red summer fruits. Soft and silkily textured on the palate, the subtle oak nuances compliment fresh blackberry, currant and spicy flavours leading into a finish of good persistence.
