



2018 Razorback Road Sauvignon Blanc

Named after the location of the Estate vineyards in the Adelaide Hills, the cool climate and long growing season in the vineyard has given our 2018 Sauvignon Blanc fresh fruit flavours and a vibrant acidity. Lightly cropped vines and hand picking of the grapes have preserved the elegant characters of Sauvignon. Careful handling in the winery with temperature controlled fermentation ensures that nature's good work in the vineyard is expressed as vibrant, intense and complex flavours in the bottle.

Tasting Notes

Our 2018 estate grown Sauvignon Blanc has concentration and mid-palate texture, reflecting the low yields of fruit picked in the early morning hours to take advantage of cool temperatures.

There are delicate lifted passionfruit aromas with notes of lime and nashi pear. The tropical palate is intense and fresh, showing remarkable fruit purity.
